Fly Tying Clinic & Fishing Trip

Gather around the table for a detailed lesson in the art of fly tying. A professional guide and instructor will teach you how to match the hatch using different hackles, feathers and an assortment of fly-mimicking materials. You won't have to wait long to try out your new handmade flies. The guide will take you to Spanish Peaks Fish Camp to hook some feisty native Cutthroats.

Fish Camp

If you enjoy the solitude of a mountain stream, the thrill of catching trout on a dry fly and quality time outdoors with your entire family, the Spanish Peaks Fish Camp will undoubtedly hold a special place in your heart. Fish Camp is a catch and release, barbless hook fishing area located on Club property at the South Fork of the West Fork of the Gallatin River. To visit Fish Camp please call Member Services.

RIDE HORSEBACK

For children under seven, a pony ride in the corral is a perfect introduction to riding horseback. Call Member Services to make arrangements.

Spanish Peaks Day Rides

1½ hour trail ride | \$50/person

3 hour trail ride | \$100/person

Enjoy a leisurely, guided trail ride through the forests, meadows and ridge tops at Spanish Peaks. Sign up for a 1½ hour or 3 hour trail ride any day of the summer.

Riders must be at least seven years old. Long pants and closed-toe/closed-heel shoes are required. Bring a sweatshirt or a light jacket. Helmets are available.

Yellowstone Day Rides

Yellowstone Day Ride | \$200/person

See unspoiled nature and wildlife as you ride through the Northwest corner of Yellowstone National Park. Depart from Big Sky at 9AM for a day adventure with lunch included.

Two person minimum, riders must be 10 years or older, 24-hour advanced reservations are required and, as always, helmets are available.

Day Ride Cancellation Policy: Reservations that are cancelled within 24 hours of scheduled rides will be charged 100% of the trip cost. If the trip is cancelled due to extreme weather conditions or National Park issued closings, there will be no charge and we will do our best to reschedule your outing.

Yellowstone Overnight Pack Trips

Many of the park's greatest treasures can only be seen by those who venture into the backcountry. Enjoy spectacular Yellowstone with first class service. Join an SP Pack Trip complete with gentle horses, gourmet food and unforgettable scenery. Spend three days and two nights or ask us about longer trips. Gather your friends and family together because these exceptional trips should not be missed!

All meals, horseback riding and camping equipment are provided. An itinerary, packing list and confirmation letter will be provided when you make your reservation. There is a six person maximum and a two person minimum. Additional parties may be added to trips with fewer than six people. Riders must be at least 12 years old. First-time participants will be given a one-hour complimentary trail ride. For all riders, an orientation and saddle fitting is required prior to the trip date. Please let us know of your dietary restrictions at the time of reservation.

Available dates include: July 12th and 26th, Aug 2nd and 9th and Sept 6th

Overnight Pack Trips Cancellation Policy: A non-refundable 50% charge will be billed when the trip has been booked, the itinerary has been confirmed with Yellowstone National Park and the confirmation has been sent. Members are required to make a non-refundable deposit of 50% of the total trip cost. For cancellations less than 30 days from the trip, the Member will be charged in full for the total trip price. If the Club cancels due to extreme weather conditions or the National Park issued closings, there will be no charge and your initial 50% will be refunded.

HIKING

Guided Full Day Hikes

9AM-5PM | Saturdays

\$75/person, includes guide, lunch and transportation (discounted group rates available) This weekly adventure has quickly become a Member favorite. Join your guide, naturalist and Sherpa for a day on one of Gallatin County's classic backcountry trails. Climb Storm Castle for 360 degree views, explore Beehive Basin's alpine meadows or cast for rising trout in Lava Lake. These are a few of the classic hikes just minutes from Spanish Peaks. All day hikes include a sack lunch that we enjoy along the trail. Hikes range from an easy 4½ mile out-and-back to a difficult 12 mile summit hike.

Ridge Runners

8AM | Sundays

Looking to fit in your daily run and reluctant to hit the road alone? Show up at the Clubhouse every Sunday morning for a quick breakfast and head out with your Spanish Peaks running buddies. Two distances are offered, a three mile and a six mile route. If you like road running, look no further; we have some of the most incredible mountain roads in the Rockies right outside our door. Plus there are jeep roads and singletrack that go for miles in all directions if you prefer trail running. This group run is unguided; however, Member Services can recommend fun and suitable routes.

Have you ever wanted to experience Montana trails on two wheels? Now is your chance to get a hands-on introductory clinic into the world of mountain biking. A seasoned mountain bike enthusiast with a background in recreational riding and racing, will show you proper pedaling and shifting techniques, efficient climbing methods, bike handling skills and safe and comfortable ways to ride on this fully guided ride to Sacajawea Camp and around Flatiron Loop.

Mountain Biking is one of the best ways to experience the Montana backcountry and the Big Sky area is home to some of the best riding in the west. Join a fully guided ride ranging from intermediate to advanced and receive helpful tips along the way. The terrain varies from long climbs and descents on Forest Service roads to smooth, rolling single-track and everything in between. Comfortable, rock-absorbing Kona full-suspension trail bikes are available for rent in the Pro Shop, helmets included.

Paddle & Roll Kayak Lessons

Have you ever wanted to kayak the Mad Mile through House Rock like the pros? Before you go jumping into the rapids, take lessons from an experienced professional in calm water. With the help of a top-notch guide, learn how to use many different paddle strokes as well as the wet exit, T-rescue, and the ROLL all on the smooth water of the Spanish Peaks pond. Chances are, you will be hooked and out on the river in no time.

Rafting & Scenic River Trips

Experience the thrill of a rafting trip down a beautiful Montana River! Whether you wish to experience the rush of rafting on the lower whitewater of the Gallatin River, or prefer to sit back and enjoy a more scenic ride on the Yellowstone, your trip will be tailored to your comfort and skill level. Tubing & Recreation Rentals

Tubing is a very popular Montana pastime. Float stretches of the Madison River without rapids. These slow moving sections are no deeper than one or two feet, making the experience perfect for family members of all ages. Recreational rentals are available from four-wheelers to waverunners to drift boats.

Hebgen Lake
